Rx From the Heart

Program addresses emergency medication needs and sustainable pharmaceutical access through variety of resources, patient assistance, Medicare, Medicaid, etc. Case management on referred clients through majority of physicians in Josephine County. Acquired more than \$3 million in pharmaceuticals for patients. Enrollment for Oregon Prescription Drug Program for any individual.

SHIBA-Senior Health Insurance Benefits Assistance

Support in reconciling Medicare claims, supplemental insurance issues, long-term care and advocacy related to Medicare. Medicare Modernization Act outreach and eligibility screening for beneficiaries; partial Medicaid information support and advocacy for fraud cases. Low-Income Subsidy Application process with Social Security, cost-comparison for Medicare advantage plans and Part D enrollment. By appointment only.

Helpline Referral Services (479-HELP)

24 hour, 7 days a week, resource and referral line, crisis intervention and suicide prevention. Training on suicide prevention/intervention, resource/referral also available, upon request.

RAMP-Regional Accessibility & Mobility Project

Ramp building and accessibility adaptation projects to ensure individuals remain as independent as possible and able to attend appropriate care appointments by being able to get in and out of household safely.

Respite Services

Caregivers and volunteers participate in a respite care services, education and support referrals, including **Powerful Tools** training of which we have a certified trainer. Care providers of individuals suffering from dementia, stroke or Alzheimer's are encouraged to take time out and refresh, while loved one is cared for by volunteer respite workers (coordinated with SPD-RVCOG Family Caregiver Services).



Money Management

Assistance with checkbook balancing and simple bill paying; For individuals with physical or cognitive impairments or who have a need for physical assistance to maintain independent living. To access program a referral is made from partnering agencies or local businesses.

Friendly Visiting & Phone Reassurance

Volunteers help maintain independence and decrease social isolation for home-bound individuals. Services are available upon referral.

AARP Tax Aide

Free Tax preparation services for middle to low-income families, seniors and disabled, volunteers trained by IRS qualified instructors. Service includes free electronic filing at time of service.

Ready to Start School Right

Backpack School Supply program in partnership with DHS, Job Council serving over 700 youth annually. Seasonal. Holiday period is Friends In Need with Daily Courier, Jo Co Christmas Basket partnership with Rogue Gateway Rotary.

Wellness After 55

Bi monthly, topic specific to the needs of individuals 55 and older related to enhancing quality of life through healthful living. (Josephine & Jackson County)

55 Alive Driver Safety

Partner with AARP to ensure availability of classes for older adults in defensive driving habits, certificate issued on completion to reduce insurance costs in most cases. (Josephine & Jackson County)

Senior Advantage Friendship Club & RSVP Knit Club

Socialization group for older, active adults (Jackson County only), which focuses on activities of maintaining healthful living and supportive relationships inside and outside of the hospital community. Knit Club (Josephine County only) teaches all levels while creating social group activity and produces useable textile goods donated to children & senior at-risk programs.
